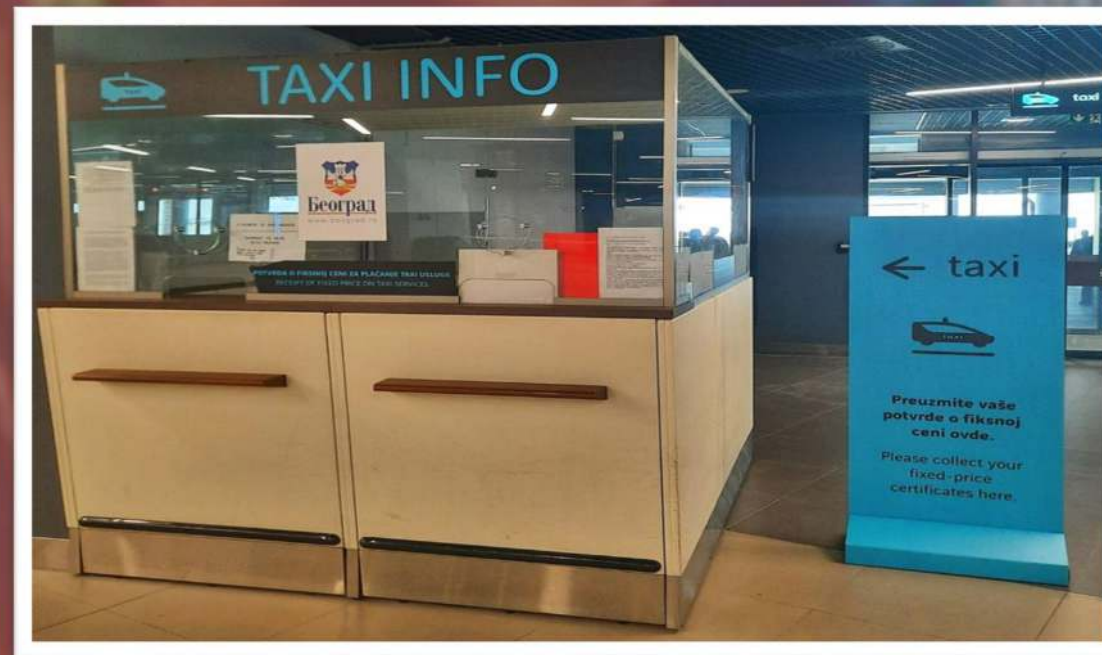




In the territory of the Republic of Serbia, you can use public transportation (A1 or 72) or taxi services to get from the airport to the hotel or other place where you are staying during your visit. As for using taxi services, we recommend you to get the voucher with a determined price for desired route. That kind of voucher you can get at the “Taxi Info-desk”.



We recommend you not to keep your payment cards and PIN codes on one place together. Also, we recommend you not to carry all the money you possess with you, but only as much as you think is needed for that day.

We advise you to keep your mobile devices in places that are less accessible to others, such as bag/purse you would carry in front of you, in order to make sure those devices are always within your sight.

Do not leave your belongings unattended and make sure you are always aware of their location.
